[Monroe, MI] — Darcy Merritt, of Monroe, MI, is serving a two-year term as Midwestern Region Governor of Soroptimist, an international volunteer organization for business and professional women who work to improve the lives of women and girls through programs leading to social and economic empowerment. Her leadership platform this biennium is "Educate to Empower," the objective of which is to increase the number of women and girls served by Soroptimist clubs throughout the Midwest. "If we educate a woman, we are empowering her to improve her life and the lives of her children," Merritt said.

Darcy studied Business at Monroe County Community College, and is retired as the branch manager and assistant vice president of Key Bank in Monroe, a company for which she worked 31 years. In addition to serving on the Executive Leadership board in Monroe, Merritt has also been active in volunteering for March of Dimes since 1992, and has served in various leadership capacities for the organization, including that of a board member for March of Dimes Ann Arbor.
