On a cold winter day there is nothing better than a hot bowl of soup to warm your bones. Here is a recipe for Broccoli Cheese Soup for you to try!

Broccoli Cheese Soup

- | | |
|--------------------------------|-----------------------------|
| 1/2 stick of butter | 1 med. onion, chopped |
| 2 stalks celery, thinly sliced | 1/4 c. flour |
| 3 c. chicken broth | Salt and Pepper to taste |
| 1 Lg head broccoli, chopped | 1 carrot, peeled and grated |
| 2 c. milk | 3 c. shredded cheddar |



In a large pot over medium heat, melt butter. Add onion and celery and cook until soft, 5 minutes. Whisk in flour and let cook 1 minute. Slowly add chicken broth and season with salt and pepper. Stir in broccoli and carrots. Bring to a boil and reduce heat to low. Let simmer until vegetables are tender, about 20 minutes. Slowly add milk and bring to a simmer, then stir in cheddar cheese. Season with salt and pepper and top with more cheddar. Serve with bread or crackers.
